The Capital City Teacher Residency (CCTR) is a fully online program that provides a unique pathway to earning a PK-5 Ohio or intervention specialist teaching license and potential bachelor's degree in education in as few as two years. All CCTR students will have access to dedicated support from Capital University faculty mentors, the flexibility to earn while learning, and the opportunity to earn a degree from a university with a long-standing reputation for excellence in education.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Open to students who have earned an associate's degree or higher. Some prerequisites are required.
- CCTR students is a two-year fully online program. Students work full-time with a school district in a paid, full-time position during the day and complete coursework during non-working hours. Earn while you learn!
- Students in the CCTR program will graduate with PK-5 or Intervention Specialist licensure with the option to earn a bachelor's degree in education from Capital University.
- CCTR students with a bachelor's degree are eligible for adolescence to young adult licensures. The bachelor's degree must be in the content area of licensure.
- As one of the longest running education programs in Ohio, Capital University has a reputation for excellence earned by our emphasis on faculty-mentored learning and individual student success. Capital is accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) and all licensure programs are approved by The Ohio Department of Education.
